In today's world there is no safe place from an active shooter situation. - A shooting that involved at least one person being shot (not including the shooter)
- A shooting that occurred on school grounds
- Included grades K through college/university level
- Included gang violence, fights and domestic violence
- Accidental discharge of a firearm as long as the first two parameters are met
